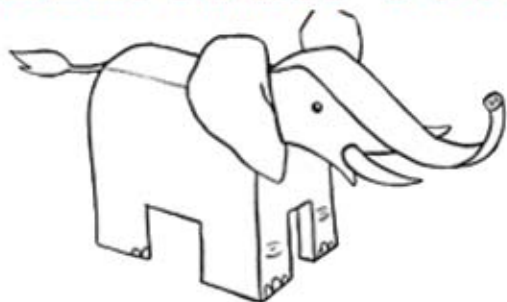
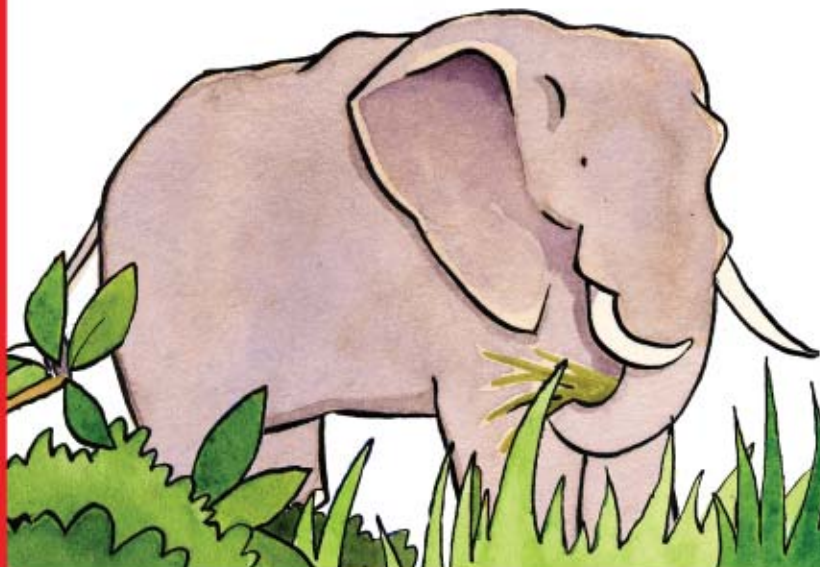
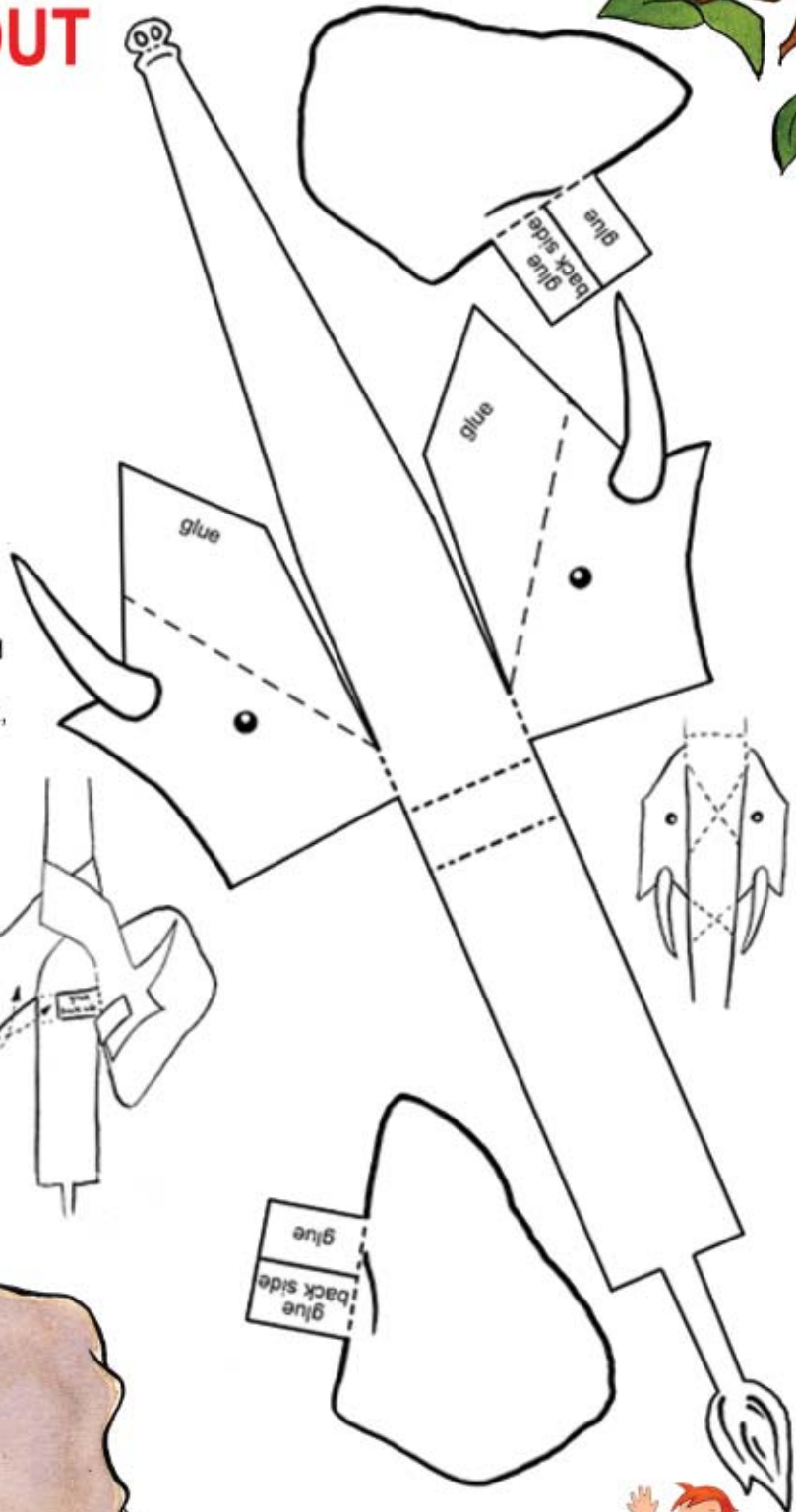


ELEPHANT CUTOUT



1. Cut around shapes on both pages.
2. On main body, cut in on solid lines on central tabs, but not the 'T'-cut on the legs, fold down the bell-shaped panels.
3. Glue the bell-shaped panels together, so tabs A and A match up, and B and B.
4. Glue small tabs under arch of body.
5. Cut out the 'T' between the legs, fold.
6. On head piece, fold sides of the face on dotted line and glue under trunk (see picture).
7. Cut ear tabs in half on solid lines. Fold the top tab back, and the bottom tab forward.
8. On underside of head, match the top ear tab to the back side of the dotted rectangle on the neck, glue (see picture).
9. Glue lower ear tab inside cheek (see picture). Repeat with the other ear.
10. Fold up on the dotted line on the lower neck.
11. Spread glue thickly on underside of long panel, attach firmly along top of main body. (Be sure the toenails face forward!)
12. Fold and glue small tab on end of trunk. Roll trunk around a pencil.

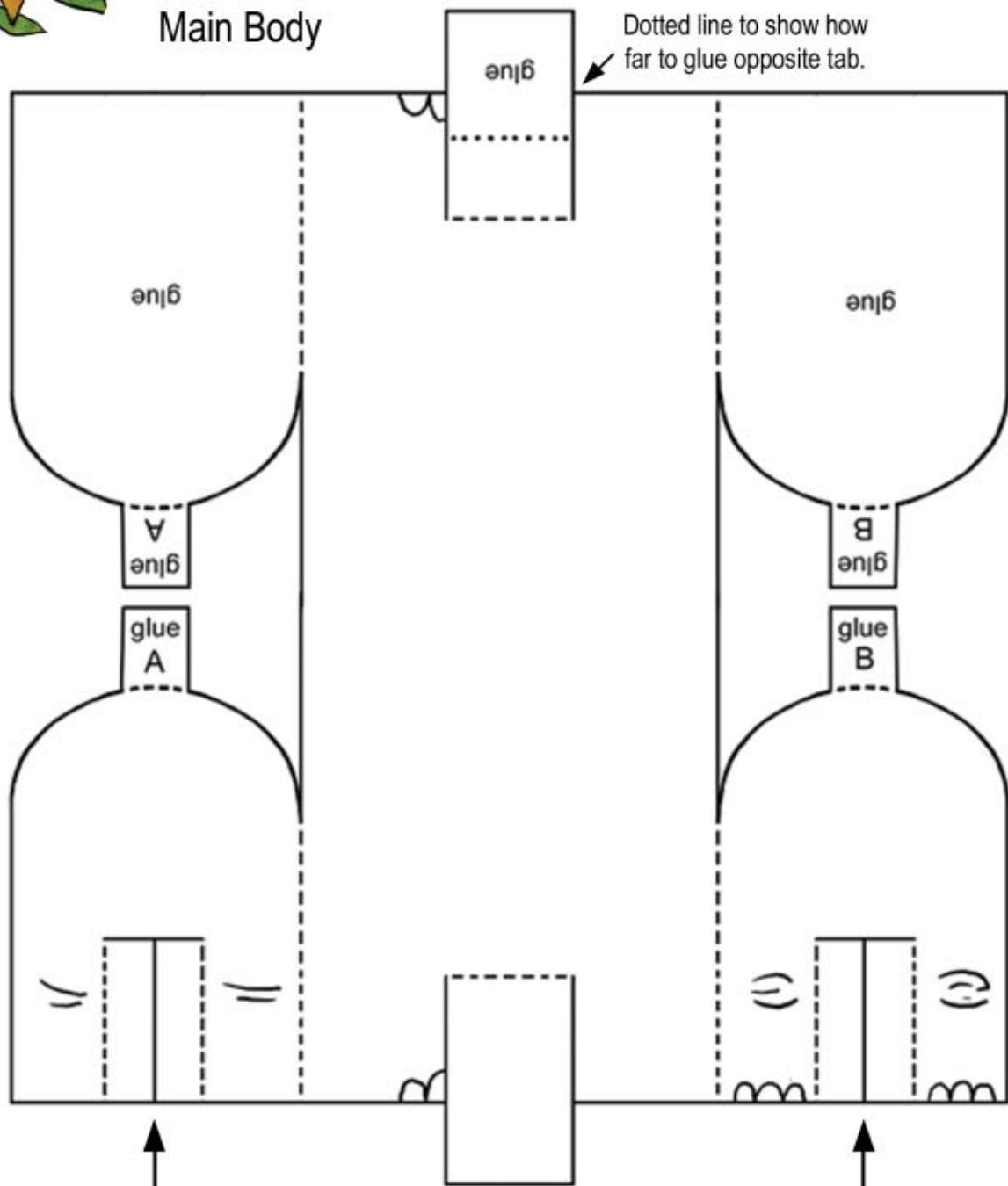
