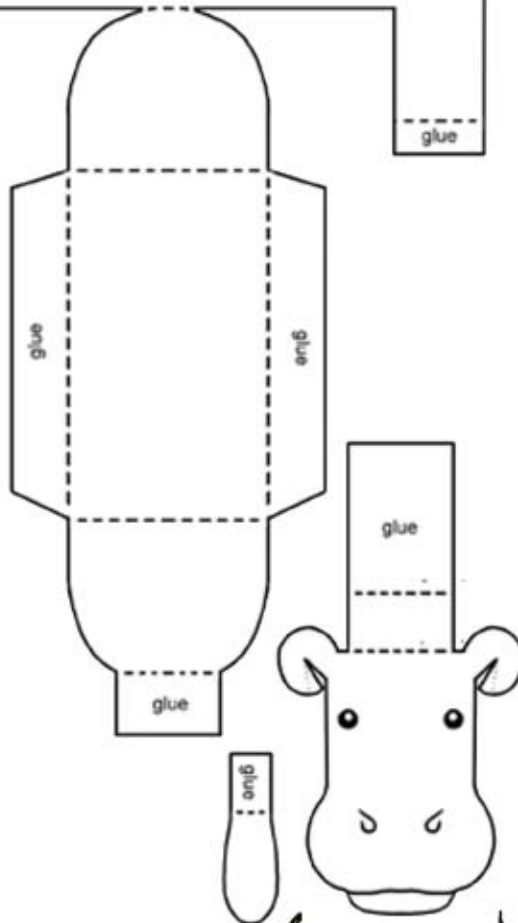
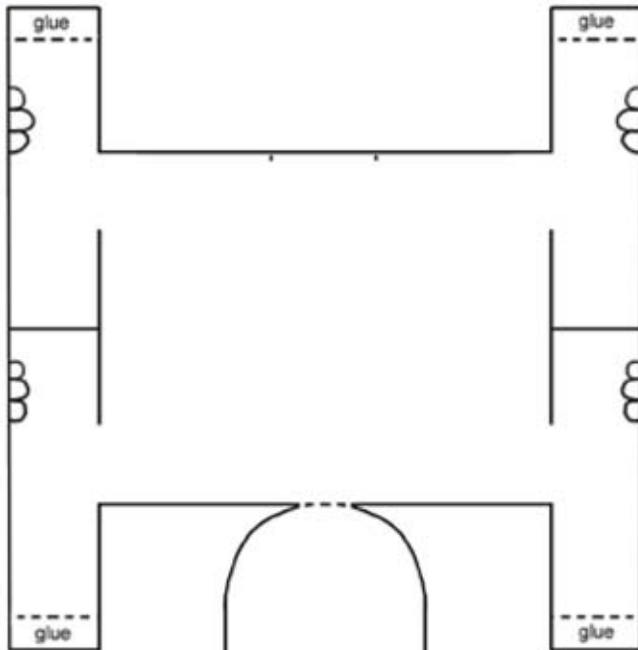
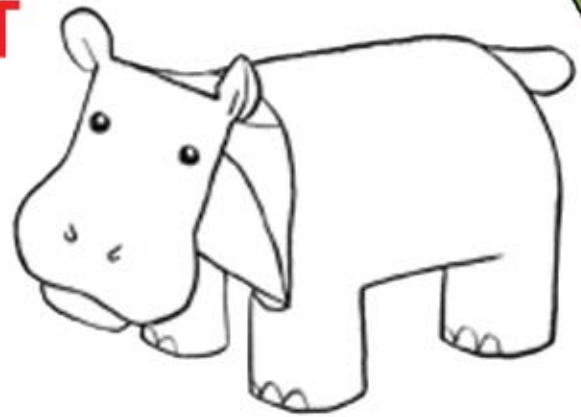


HIPPO CUTOUT



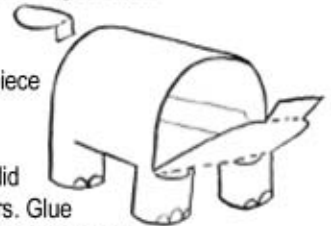
1. Cut around the three shapes.
2. Cut in on solid T-shaped lines.
3. On one of the four leg pieces, spread the tab with glue, then roll the piece so the solid end meets the dotted line (see picture).



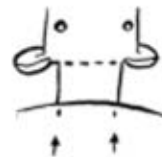
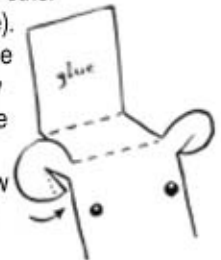
4. On the other section of this piece, fold down on the dotted lines.
5. Wrap this section around half the width of the legs. Bring up the sides with the tabs to the leg base. Be sure the tabs come right to the edges of the base.

6. Glue the tail.

7. Take the head piece and fold on the dotted lines.



8. Cut in on the solid lines inside the ears. Glue the dotted tabs behind the other half of the ear (see picture).
9. Glue the large tab on the head underneath the body arc, matching it up with the dots on the body.
10. Glue the tab on the low the underside of the face.
