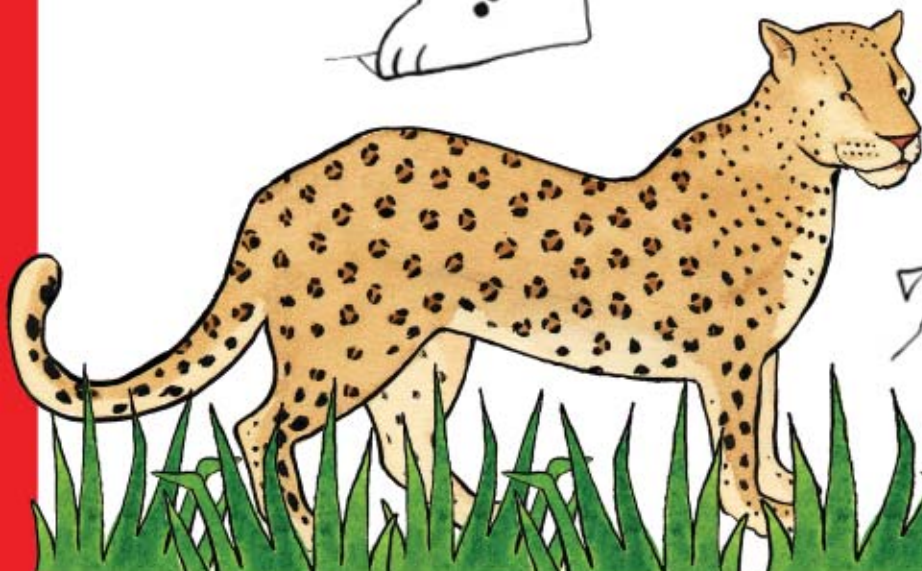
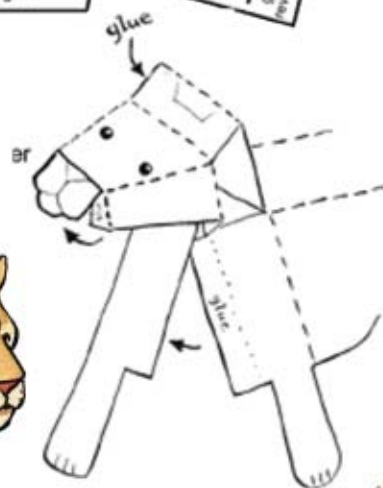
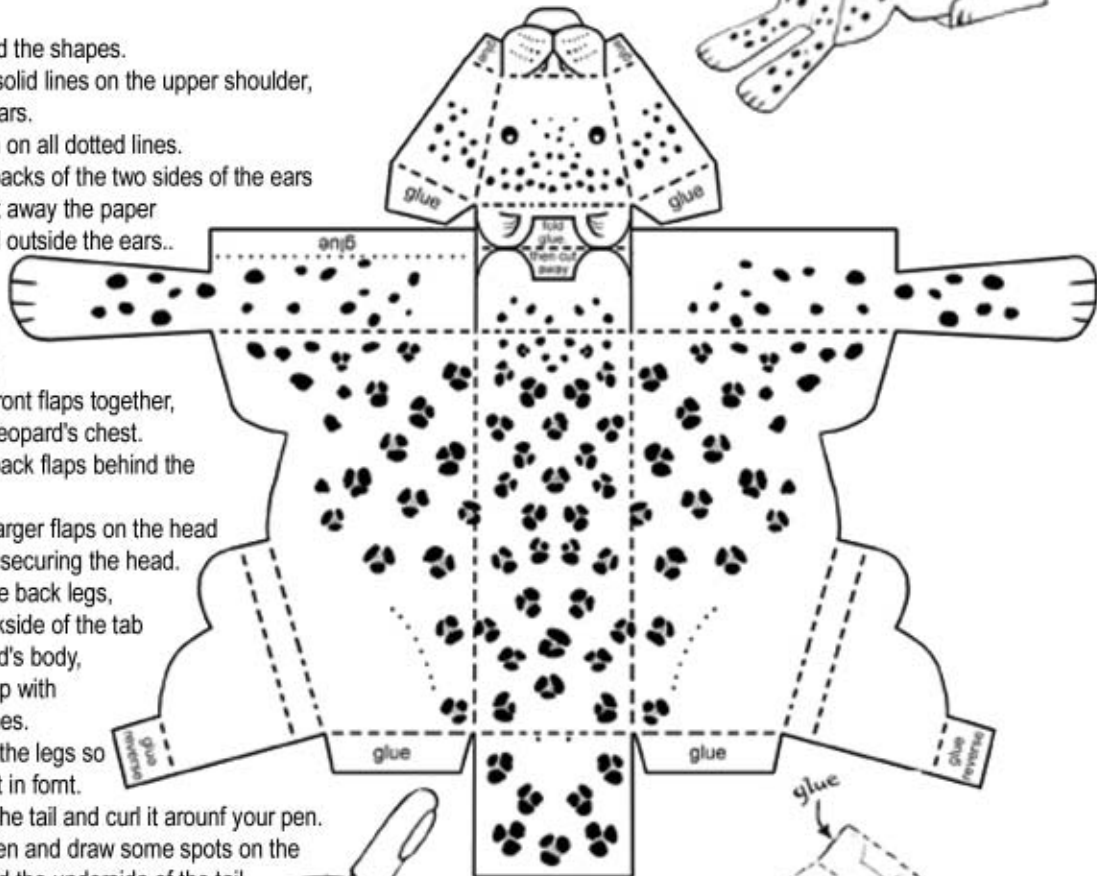


# LEOPARD CUTOUT

1. Cut around the shapes.
2. Cut in on solid lines on the upper shoulder, but not the ears.
3. Fold down on all dotted lines.
4. Glue the backs of the two sides of the ears together. Cut away the paper between and outside the ears..
5. Glue the small face flaps behind the muzzle.
6. Glue the front flaps together, forming the leopard's chest.
7. Glue the back flaps behind the back panel.
8. Glue the larger flaps on the head to the chest, securing the head.
9. Fold up the back legs, glue the backside of the tab to the leopard's body, matching it up with the dotted lines.
10. Bend up the legs so they stick out in front.
11. Glue on the tail and curl it around your pen.
12. Take a pen and draw some spots on the back legs and the underside of the tail.
